

## **SCHOOL BUS DRIVING POSITION**

This is a part time position that offers limited voluntary health benefits.

Morning hours are between approximately 6:00 AM and 9:30 AM dependent on the length of a particular bus run, generally from one and a half to two and a half hours. Afternoon runs start at approximately 2:15 PM and usually end no later than 5:00 PM.

The pay is a flat rate per day starting as low as \$35 per day, but in most cases from \$48 to \$65 per day.

Extra work is paid by the hour from start to finish. Example: driving for field trips is paid at \$10.50 per hour.

## **ABOUT GETTING A CDL LICENSE**

If you do not hold a commercial driver's license (CDL), Rohrer Bus Service will train you to become a licensed school bus driver. Since we pay a significant amount for everything necessary for licensing we DO NOT pay you to train.

Training takes approximately 6 weeks (off and on) from the initial interview and usually occurs between about 9:30 AM and 1:00 PM.

To become a school bus driver you must:

- 1) Complete 14 hours of classroom time provided once a month for four straight nights at our Duncannon office, from 5 PM to 9 PM, Monday through Thursday.
- 2) Pass four knowledge tests with PennDOT—we supply the books and tutor you to pass the computer exams.
- 3) Complete at least 6 hours of hands-on, in-bus training (if you never have driven this type of vehicle up to 20 hours of behind the wheel training is realistic).
