SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENTS

A MESSAGE FROM OUR SAFETY DIRECTOR

"COVID-19 has certainly impacted everyone's life. It is with sincere concern that we are taking every precaution possible to protect our employees and families. Daily disinfecting is being performed multiple times throughout the day focusing on everything that might be a source of contact in our daily operations. Procedures and checklists are in place for training and testing, keeping safety our top priority. Access controls have been put in place for employees, customers, and contractors requiring access to the facility. Start up plans are underway for vehicles and drivers to insure everyone is protected from any possible exposures.

Another reminder: I would also stress to everyone, avoid convenience stores along or close to major highways. That means avoiding the Sheetz across the street from the Duncannon office for those who frequent the location. It appears that the virus is following along major routes across Pennsylvania. These protective measures will continue to be revisited and updated as necessary, and I encourage feedback from employees. The procedures and protocols will be sent out to District Supervisors. Hospital grade (Sanox) cleaning solutions will be supplied. With everyone working as a team and following common sense guidelines, I am confident we can work safely. With the measures being taken, I myself, feel safer coming to work than going to the grocery store. ACT 126 TRAINING

Important reminder about Act 126 training. Everyone needs to recertify every 5 years. If your certification is expired, this needs to be completed before you can drive. STAY SAFE AND HEALTHY!

While a lot of us are in counties that have moved into the "yellow phase" of reopening businesses, unfortunately, coronavirus is still a threat to everybody's health. Please continue to practice the following safety tips:

1. Wash your hands!

This is the most important measure to take to prevent the spread of coronavirus. Wash your hands often, and carry around lotion to put on if you're prone to chapping and cracking. If you're on the move, make sure you carry around hand sanitizer and apply often.

2. Distance yourself!

Stay inside your house and avoid unnecessary trips. If you need to go out for necessities, such as groceries, try to keep 6 feet of space between yourself and others, and wear a face mask. Avoid gatherings of more than 10 people at a time, and do not be afraid to cancel plans during this vulnerable time.

3. Disinfect your surfaces!

During this time, disinfectant wipes are your friend! Clean your frequently touched surfaces daily. This includes phones, steering wheels, keyboards and mice, desks, table, doorknobs, and light switches.

4. Know the symptoms!

COVID-19 has a couple symptoms, most commonly including fever, shortness of breath, cough, and sometimes a sore throat. Since it shares many symptoms with the flu or a cold, it might be difficult for you to determine if you're infected with coronavirus. If you get sick, CALL A DOCTOR! COVID-19 can develop into more serious conditions, like pneumonia, so when in doubt, get it checked out!

DRIVER RECERTIFICATION CLASSES

This year, we are holding recertification classes for ONLY those who will be downgraded before the beginning of the school year. This means that if you were not contacted by the training department or you supervisor, you are not scheduled for the June recertification class. We are starting to hold new certification classes beginning in June as long as your local PennDOT is open so you are able to test on your endorsements right away. We are limiting the number of people to attend class due to size and all must be screened prior to coming in for class and wear a mask at all times. 

PART-TIME POSITIONS!

School Bus and Van Drivers

We are collecting applications and training School Bus and Van Drivers to start taking kids to school **next school year**. Despite the challenges presented to us by COVID-19, we are confident that our team of skilled trainers and drivers can train new employees safely and successfully by adhering to the CDC and OSHA guidance.

For example, in the Classroom phase of training, all surfaces will be sanitized prior to and at the end of class, chairs will be set up at least 6 feet apart, trainers and trainees will wear masks, hand washing/hand sanitizer will be exercised throughout training, and individual meals will be provided to prevent communal eating, and subsequently the possible spread of pathogens. During in-bus training, trainers will try to maintain 6 feet of distance as much as possible (using stepstools to see better and asking the trainee to speak louder), masks and gloves will be worn by all parties, and the vehicle will be disinfected before and after training.
