

SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENTS

WORKPLACE INJURIES

Reporting work injuries in a timely manner is critical in providing guidance to the injured employee and their supervisor. Please report all work injuries **immediately** to your supervisor. Your supervisor will provide you with a Work Injury Report to be completed as soon as possible which needs to be emailed to **Steve Hoffmaster** as soon as possible, but **no later than 18 hours** for a minor injury. For a significant injury, the Work Injury Report must be emailed to Steve **ASAP**, **and within 7 hours** of the injury. This is critical to be in compliance with OSHA and our Workers' Compensation insurance carrier. Steve's email address is **shoffmaster@rohrerbus.com**, office number is **(717) 957-3811, ext. 1306**, and cell phone is **(717) 798-2758**. If you cannot reach your supervisor, reach out to Steve. Make sure the Work Injury Report is the March 2023 version, not a previous, outdated version.

ACCIDENT AND INCENDENT REPORTS

Accident Reports and Incident Reports must reach the Safety Department within 24 hours of accident/incident. This is critical in processing the paperwork efficiently and notifying PennDOT, insurance company(ies), vehicle/property owners, police departments, etc., as needed. Remember, you are not required to give a statement at an accident scene. Inform the officer/trooper that you will be completing a report and Rohrer Bus Service will gladly provide them a copy of the report. Do not admit fault/guilt at an accident scene.

SPEED MONITORING

Your Safety Department will be actively monitoring speeding and will be reaching out to supervisors of violating drivers. Depending on your history, you may be asked to sign an Employee Discussion Report or an Employee Warning Notice to properly document the infraction. Supervisors may be doing this at the request of the Safety Department, so if you want to be upset with someone, it is not your supervisor. We expect you to operate your vehicle at a safe speed and not exceed the speed limit partly due to public perception, but mostly because it is dangerous to you, your students, and all motorists you encounter. Speeding is against company policy, is illegal, and is a significant factor in many crashes. If your run causes you to get behind schedule, discuss it with your supervisor to see what changes can resolve it. Safety 1st, Schedule 2nd!

Ice Cleat Indicators

Blue indicator lights will be installed on our lots to notify employees when wearing ice cleats is mandatory.
Employees are welcome to use their ice cleats even if the blue light is not illuminated. If you feel the conditions warrant you wearing your ice cleats and the blue light is not on where you park your vehicle, please wear them for your safety.

How do I refer someone so that I get a bonus?

Have you talked to a friend or family member about joining the team? When they apply to Rohrer Bus and include YOUR NAME on their employment application AND mention YOUR NAME during their initial interview, you will get listed as the person who referred them and be eligible for a bonus IF they get hired and complete certain criteria.

What does the person I refer have to do?

They have to tell us you referred them during the hiring process. They put your name on their application and then mention you during their interview. IF they get hired, and then ONCE they earn \$2000 with Rohrer Bus, you will be eligible for your referral bonus.

When do I GET my referral bonus?

Referral bonuses are paid out quarterly in March, June, September and December. Once the new employee earns their \$2000, you will see your bonus in the last paycheck of the next quarterly payout month.

In Summary:

GETTING A REFERRAL BONUS: When a new employee writes **your name** on their employment application as the person who referred them and they also state your name during the interview process.

CALCULATING A REFERRAL BONUS: The new employee needs to earn \$2,000.00 in wages.

RECEIVING A REFERRAL BONUS: Paid on a quarterly basis; March, June, September, December. You will see the Referral Bonus in your pay on the next payout after the new employee that you referred has earned the necessary wages.
