SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENTS

UPDATE: NEW REQUIREMENT ADDED TO VAN DRIVER CHILD CHECK PROCEDURE

Safety remains our top priority, and thorough Child Checks are essential to ensuring no student is ever left unattended in a vehicle. All drivers, bus and van alike, are required to inspect their vehicle after each run, checking all seats, under seats, behind backrests, and storage areas for any sleeping or hiding children.

NEW FOR VAN DRIVERS:

Effective immediately, all van drivers must display a **laminated "Child Check" sign** in the **rear driver's side window** after completing their post-run inspection. This visual indicator confirms that no students remain onboard. The sign must be removed before beginning the next route.

Other van Child Check steps remain unchanged: drivers should turn on interior lights in low visibility, use a flashlight if needed, and remove sunglasses to improve visibility during inspection. Be sure to check every seat surface, under and between seats, and in storage or wheelchair areas.

Failure to perform a proper Child Check may result in termination. If a child is ever found onboard after a run, notify your supervisor immediately. Let's continue working together to keep our students safe.

New Backing Policy

To minimize the risk of preventable backing accidents, the Safety Department is implementing a new backing policy **effective immediately**.

Policy Overview

If you find yourself in a situation where you believe backing up is necessary during your bus or van run, **STOP and call your supervisor** using the 2-way radio for guidance.

Your supervisor will provide safer alternatives to avoid unnecessary backing.

Staying on schedule is not a valid reason to back up in an attempt to regain lost time.

Why This Policy Matters

While backing up may seem like a quick solution, an accident can lead to significant delays.

A single backing accident could result in:

Taking photos of the scene

Exchanging information

Police involvement

School district administrators arriving on-site These situations will consume far more time than any minutes saved by backing up.

Backing is only permitted in the following scenarios:

Authorized Rohrer Bus parking areas Authorized school district turnarounds as part of your designated route
