SAFETY ANNOUNCEMENTS

SAFETY FIRST: THE SERIOUS RISKS OF SPEEDING IN A SCHOOL BUS

As school bus drivers, we carry the most precious cargo on the road: our children. With that responsibility comes the need for constant vigilance and a commitment to safe driving practices. One of the most critical safety issues we face is speeding.

Speed limits exist for a reason, especially when operating large vehicles like school buses. Our buses are heavier and less maneuverable than passenger cars, which means they require more time and distance to stop. When a bus is traveling above the speed limit, it significantly increases the risk of losing control or being unable to stop in time to avoid an accident.

All of our routes take us through school zones, residential streets, and rural roads; areas where children may be walking, biking, or playing nearby. Vehicles parked along streets, traffic and other environmental factors make it difficult to identify and react to all risk factors guickly. Even a few miles per hour over the limit can be the difference between a safe trip and a serious incident.

Speeding doesn't just endanger our students and other people—it also puts your career at risk. Rohrer, along with our partner school districts, enforces strict policies around speed violations. A single lapse in judgment can lead to disciplinary action, job loss, or the suspension of a commercial driver's license.

Remember: the goal isn't just to be on time. It's to be safe. Arriving a few minutes late is always better than taking risks that could lead to tragedy.

Let's all commit to staying within speed limits, staying alert, and putting safety first every time we're behind the wheel. Our children, and their families, are counting on us.

MOTORCYCLE SAFETY

As spring weather arrives and the school year ends, both motorcycle traffic and accident rates increase. Stay alert for motorcycles, especially when merging or turning onto highways. In low light, motorcycles may be harder to see and appear farther away than they are, leading to potential collisions. Extra caution can help prevent serious accidents.

DRIVING LAW UPDATE

NEW PENNSYLVANIA LAW BANS HANDHELD CELLPHONE USE WHILE DRIVING

Starting in early 2025, Pennsylvania will enforce a new law that prohibits drivers from holding a **cellphone** while operating a vehicle. Known as the "Paul Miller Law," it aims to reduce distracted driving incidents and enhance road safety across the state. Drivers can still use hands-free devices, but holding a phone, **even at a red light**, will result in a \$50 fine. The law includes a grace period for first-time offenders, focusing on education before enforcement ramps up. This change brings Pennsylvania in line with most other U.S. states that already have similar laws.

As Rohrer Bus employees, safety is our top priority. We should already be setting the standard by keeping our focus on the road while driving. Let's continue to lead by example and prioritize safety for ourselves and our communities around us.

SUMMER SAFETY TIPS

Heat Stroke:

- -Dehydration can lead to heat exhaustion and eventually heat stroke, which can cause permanent health issues or death.
- -While most employees work in climate-controlled environments, summer camp drivers and those with outdoor activities are at risk.
- -Begin hydrating the day/night before outdoor activities.
- -Ensure adequate water or sports drinks are available for everyone involved.

Miscellaneous Tips:

- Always wear sunscreen (at least SPF 30) when going outside, even on cloudy days.
- Make sure to reapply sunscreen every 3 hours, or right after you get out of water.
- Never leave kids swimming unattended, and provide floaties, a raft, or pool noodles.
- Wear insect repellant spray when going outside, especially in wooded areas or near water, to prevent uncomfortable or dangerous bug bites.
- Always wear a helmet when skating, riding a scooter, or riding a bike.
- Never let kids wait in a parked car; temperatures could become deadly in minutes.

Earn your Referral Bonus We want your friends and family to work with us!

This is just a reminder that whenever you refer a friend or family member to come work at Rohrer Bus, you get a referral bonus! Remember, the referral bonus for referring a school bus driver is \$1000, and a van driver is \$500! We are in need of school bus and van drivers, but are also hiring for a couple full-time positions you can find online at rohrerbus.com/careers. Encourage your friends and family to apply online at rohrerbus.com/drive or call us at (717) 957-3811, and don't forget to give them your employee number!

How do I refer someone so that I get a bonus?- Have you talked to a friend or family member about joining the team? When they apply to Rohrer Bus and include YOUR NAME on their employment application AND mention YOUR NAME during their initial interview, you will get listed as the person who referred them and be eligible for a bonus IF they get hired and complete certain criteria.

What does the person I refer have to do?- They have to tell us you referred them during the hiring process. They put your name on their application and then mention you during their interview. IF they get hired, and then ONCE they earn \$2000 with Rohrer Bus, you will be eligible for your referral bonus.

When do I GET my referral bonus?- Referral bonuses are paid out quarterly in March, June, September and December. Once the new employee earns their \$2000, you will see your bonus in the last paycheck of the next quarterly payout month.
